## The CCPC History

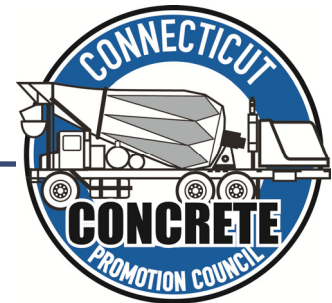
