GENERAL PERMIT FOR THE DISCHARGE OF STORMWATER AND DEWATERING WASTEWATERS FROM CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES (CONSTRUCTION GENERAL PERMIT)

DEEP is in the final stages of reissuing the General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities (construction general permit). The Department plans to reissue this permit within the next few weeks. Even though the current permit doesn't expire until September 30, the first registrations under the new permit will need to be submitted at least by August 1 and some by July 1 or this year.

There are significant changes coming and the registration and compliance process for this permit is much more comprehensive than the current permit. Some of the important changes include:

- increased emphasis on impaired waters;
- new post-construction stormwater standards;
- LID and runoff reduction measures; rainfall turbidity sampling;
- new endangered species requirements;
- third party plan review certification and inspection; and
- new provisions for public availability and comment.
