## Truck Inspection; what is it and what should I expect?

The Department of Motor Vehicles, Commercial Vehicle Safety Division will be conducting several “training and education” events in conjunction with training taking place at four of the State’s weight and inspection stations.

We encourage trucking companies (motor carriers) who are unfamiliar with the inspection process to come and visit during one of the scheduled events between the hours of 8 and 11 am. Personnel on-site will perform a level I inspection on your vehicle or if you do not have your vehicle with you, an Inspector will show and explain to you the process. Note: In the event of inclement weather, level II inspections may be conducted.

### **Dates and locations:**

April 16 - Greenwich (Interstate 95 north between exits 2 and 3)  
April 18 - Danbury (Interstate 84 east at exit 2 in the rest area)  
April 19 - Union (Interstate 84 west between exits 74 and 73)  
April 30 - Middletown (Interstate 91 north between exits 19 and 20 in the rest area)  
May 1 - Union (Interstate 84 west between exits 74 and 73)

**Reminders:** Please be sure that your vehicles are properly equipped and maintained as well as your drivers being properly qualified and licensed. Vehicles and drivers found to be in non-compliance will be declared out-of-service for violations discovered that are considered to be out-of-service. If you arrive at the site between 8 and 11 a.m. and the signs are “CLOSED”, please drive in and advise personnel that you are here for the “training and education” event.
