A Conversation with Former OSHA Assistant Area Director and Current Safety Consultant Rick Kaletsky

We are pleased to open our fall season of Safety Roundtables with a conversation with Rick Kaletsky, a former assistant area director for OSHA, and now current safety consultant. Mr. Kaletsky will lead a discussion about current OSHA policies and procedures, and whether or not the agency is adopting a more stringent enforcement position under the Obama Administration. Prior to founding his firm in 1992, he worked for OSHA for 20 years, serving as a compliance safety and health officer (safety specialist category), supervisory safety specialist, and assistant area director, in Connecticut. He is the author of OSHA Inspections: Preparation and Response (updated/enhanced for 2011 11th printing, published by the National Safety Council), a step-by-step guide to the entire OSHA process.
