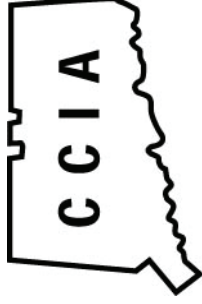

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION AND DUES SCHEDULE

(Revised August 2010)

The following information explains the dues assessment and procedure for all CCIA membership categories.

ACTIVE LABOR RELATIONS

Connecticut based members engaged in the business of a CCIA division who do not authorize CCIA as representative for labor relations matters.

Dues Assessment

Minimum Annual Dues: \$ 500*
Maximum Annual Dues: \$7,500

Annual dues are based on the minimum dues of \$500 plus 2.6 mills of the total Connecticut gross payroll in excess of \$250,000.

Members in this category must submit copies of their quarterly Connecticut payroll tax return form CT-941 (upon request) in order for CCIA to calculate their annual dues. Failure to submit these forms may result in the assessment of maximum dues of \$7,500.

**Payments of CCLA Industry Advancement or Promotion programs are required of companies bound to Connecticut collective bargaining agreements and will result in credit towards member's annual dues on a dollar for dollar basis. Maximum credit allowance is \$7,400 with a required \$100 annual dues payment.*

ACTIVE NON-LABOR RELATIONS

Connecticut based members engaged in the business of a CCIA division who do not authorize CCIA as representative for labor relations matters.

Dues Assessment

Minimum Annual Dues: \$ 500*
Maximum Annual Dues: \$3,750

Annual dues are based on the minimum dues of \$500 plus 1.9 mills of the total Connecticut gross payroll in excess of \$125,000.

Members in this category must submit copies of their quarterly Connecticut payroll tax return form CT-941 (upon request) in order for CCIA to calculate their annual dues. Failure to submit these forms may result in the assessment of maximum dues of \$3,750.

**Payments of CCIA Industry Advancement or Promotion programs are required of companies bound to Connecticut collective bargaining agreements and will result in credit towards member's annual dues on a basis of \$0.50 on the dollar. Maximum credit allowance is \$3,650 with a required \$100 annual dues payment*

OUT-OF-STATE LABOR CONTRACTOR

Contractors based outside of Connecticut engaged in the business of a CCIA division who authorize CCIA as representative for labor relations matters.

Dues Assessment

Minimum Annual Dues: \$ 500*
Maximum Annual Dues: \$7,500

Dues calculations are based on the total dollar amount of work performed within Connecticut. Annual dues are based on the minimum annual dues of \$500 plus \$500 for every million dollars (or fraction thereof) of work in excess of 2 million dollars per year.

Members in this category must notify CCIA annually of all work performed within Connecticut as a sub-contractor or general contractor, in both the public and private sectors.

**Payments to CCLA Industry Advancement or Promotion programs are required of companies bound to Connecticut collective bargaining agreements and will result in credit towards member's annual dues on a dollar for dollar basis. Maximum credit allowance is \$7,400 with a required \$100 annual dues payment.*

OUT-OF-STATE NON-LABOR CONTRACTOR

Contractors based outside of Connecticut engaged in the business of a CCIA division who do not authorize CCIA as representative for labor relations matters.

Dues Assessment

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ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Members who do not engage in the same business activity as the active members of a CCIA Division, but who service or supply active members of a CCIA Division.

Annual Dues: \$575

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES MEMBERS

Members who do not engage in the same business activity as the active members of a CCIA Division, but who provide active members of a CCIA Division with professional services including: law firms, insurance companies, financial services, and accounting firms.

Annual Dues: \$750

ALLIED MEMBERS

Members who do not engage in the same business activity as the active members of a CCIA division and do not service or supply active members of a CCIA division, or all associates or groups which do not attain *Association Membership* as defined in the CCIA Constitution and By-Laws.

Annual Dues: \$300

DUES PROCEDURE

Connecticut Active and Non-Active Membership dues are calculated at the end of December and invoices are mailed out mid-January.

Out-of State- Active and Non-Active membership dues invoices are mailed out annually. The calculations for these dues are based on reports submitted by out-of-state members at the end of each year. The report contains the dollar amount and general information of all work performed within Connecticut for the measuring period.

Associate and Allied membership annual dues invoices are mailed out mid-January.

Dues are payable within 30 days of the invoice date.

Members may elect to pay dues on a quarterly basis. Quarterly dues installments are due on the first day of February, May, August and November.

New members pay their dues on a pro-rated basis for the year in which they are accepted into membership in CCIA.
