Liberal Democrats and Blue Dogs Clash on Health Care – Last month, AGC expressed its opposition to the massive \$1.5 trillion health care overhauls being debated in the House and Senate. AGC remains opposed to the bill because AGC members and their employees will face a nearly impossible task of keeping insurance coverage, paying for coverage and maintaining an acceptable level of coverage without being pushed into a national plan. As such, AGC currently opposes the health care reform proposals in Congress. Read More →

AGC Releases Stimulus Survey Results – AGC released results of a survey that measured the impact of stimulus funds on construction companies' ability to expand payrolls. The survey found that stimulus construction funds have had little impact to date on companies' ability to hire new employees, but has helped companies save existing jobs.

AGC Analysis Shows Construction Employment Declines – Construction employment declined in all but 19 communities nationwide this June as compared to June-2008, according to a new analysis of metropolitan-area employment data released by AGC. Read More →

Union Representation in Construction Increases Slightly in 2008 – The rate of union representation in the construction industry increased modestly in 2008 for the second consecutive year following a steady decline in the decade preceding 2006. Using <u>Bureau of Labor Statistics</u> (BLS) data, the Construction Labor Research Council (CLRC) reports in its latest biennial report on union representation trends that the percentage of workers represented by a union in 2008 was 16.2 percent. This compares with 14.4 percent in 2007 and 13.6 percent in 2006, according to BLS data. <u>Read More</u> →
